A team effort:

- Principal Real Estate Investors, LLC started the ESG program Pillars of Responsible Property Investing (PRPI) in 2008 and have a net zero carbon commitment by 2050.
- ▶ In response to the global climate emergency, Avison Young is working to reduce their carbon emissions to net zero globally by 2040, and in their U.K.-occupied buildings by 2030. As part of the World Green Building Council's Net Zero Carbon Buildings Commitment, they are also identifying renewable solutions for their offices located in high carbon utility service districts.

Sustainability practices implemented:

- ▶ On top of having EV Charging stations available and upgraded LED lighting in the parking structure, the team at Hazard Center Office has installed digital controls on the chillers and cooling towers to help with energy efficiency. They upgraded their elevators to Destination Dispatch which directs elevators to their destination by grouping people and floors which reduces energy and has converted their irrigation to drip irrigation.
- Everyone from the property manager to the engineering, security, and janitorial teams all play a role and work together to keep the space as efficient and sustainable as possible.
