A team effort:

- ▶ While ESG has been a large part of Essex's strategy for many years (first ESG report in 2018), their ESG Committee identified the need to obtain green certifications in late 2022 and set an internal goal for 2023.
- Essex has set a greenhouse gas emissions reduction target for Scope 1 & 2 emissions for 35% by 2030, from a 2018 baseline year, as well as a 10% water reduction goal by 2030, from a 2021 baseline year.
- The sustainability team at Essex developed a robust checklist to help not only identify energy reduction opportunities but ensure they are part of capital expense conversations at their properties.

Sustainability practices implemented:

- The team at Via installed LED lighting and controls in their parking garage, representing a 30% reduction in electrical usage at the site.
- They also have EV charging available on site and are currently installing a 268kW rooftop solar system.
